

Tutoring for ORU math courses is offered through the Mathematics Learning Resource Center (MLRC).

This program staffs qualified tutors to assist you in your mathematic classes.

To schedule a tutoring session for a math class:

- 1. Log into D2L
- 2. Select your math class out of "My Courses."
- 3. On the resources at the right of the page, select "Schedule a Tutor" or go to http://accudemia.oru.edu
- 4. Select "My Center Attendance."
- 5. Click on "Appointments," then "New by Date" or "New by Tutor."
- 6. Select Math Learning Resource Center.
- 7. The tutors that show "available" are qualified to tutor in your specific class for which you are enrolled.
- 8. Choose an available time and create a tutoring appointment.

When you sign up for a math tutoring appointment, the location of tutoring is listed under "Descriptions." It is important for you to pay attention to the location so you can find your tutor. Most tutoring sessions are either at the Hammer Center Living Room, or at the new CITI Lab (LRC 1B23).
