## Articulation Agreement Between Oral Roberts University and Planetshakers College December 2019 – December 2022

## Provisions governing the agreement:

- 1. PSC students must meet ORU's minimum academic and admissions requirements in order to be considered for admission to ORU.
- 2. Under the current course matrix, PSC offers 38 classes that are eligible for transfer to ORU.
- 3. A total of 30 semester hours including the senior paper/project, must be taken at ORU.
- 4. All ORU general education requirements must be fulfilled in a student's degree plan.
- 5. Only courses with a grade of "C" or better will transfer. Remedial and developmental courses will not transfer.
- 6. Representatives from ORU and PSC will periodically update transfer and admission policies, ensure that appropriate information is readily available to PSC students, and work together to develop mutually beneficial arrangements between the two institutions.
- 7. Course transfers will be reviewed and evaluated based on the ORU Course and Instructor Qualification Policies and Guidelines.
- 8. Through ORU's prior learning assessment process, adult learners may receive up to 30 hours of credit for knowledge gained through non-college courses, on-the-job training, or personal studies. This is in addition to the articulated courses transferring from PSC.
